



## OSHA 300 LOG INFORMATION

Nevada and federal OSHA Regulations require employers with more than 10 employees complete and maintain a log of recordable on-the-job injuries and illnesses.

This Claim may require entry onto the OSHA 300 Log if the injury/illness results in:

1. A death. Or;
2. Lost time is in excess of one full day (the day of the accident and the first day back to work do not count). Or;
3. Medical treatment by a physician other than what is considered First Aid. Or;
4. Restricted work activity (LIGHT DUTY). Or;
5. A job transfer due to the injury/illness. Or;
6. Any Loss of Consciousness.
